SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Program

NTI has developed a scholarship program designed to offer financial assistance to qualified bona-fide members or qualified children of bona-fide members of the Triskelion Grand Fraternity/ Sorority residing in the Philippines.

Awards range from P20,000.00 to P50,000.00 for each year of full time study. Scholarships are awarded based on academic achievement, leadership, character, financial need and contributions to the fraternity/sorority, school and/or community. Awards may be renewed annually for up to four additional years on the basis of satisfactory performance as to be determined by the Scholarship Committee.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- Must be an active member of good standing of the Triskelion Grand Fraternity or Sorority or his son/daughter for at least one year;
- Must plan to be enrolled or must currently be enrolled in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited college, university or vocational/technical school with a GPA of 2.5 or its equivalent. If not currently enrolled, the scholar must enroll in the school year in which the award is given.
- Must be recommended by either an official of his school or an official of the community where he lives and by an active member of good standing of the Triskelion Grand Fraternity or Sorority who is not related to the applicant by marriage or consanguinity.

INSTRUCTIONS

How To Get The Application Packet

You may download the application packet in our website www.northeasttriskelion.org or you may send a request through email to scholarship@northeasttriskelion.org.

Rules and Regulations

1. To be eligible for scholarship, you must be:
 - An active member in good standing of the Triskelion Grand Fraternity or Sorority for at least one year or his/her unmarried child under the age of 21;
 - A High School senior belonging to the top 30% of his graduating class or an undergraduate student currently enrolled in an accredited college, university or technical/vocational school with a grade point average of 3.0 (if 5.0 is the highest), 2.5 (if 4.0 is the highest) or 85 on a grading scale of 100;
 - Recommended by the Principal, Vice Principal, Dean or Asst. Dean of his current school or an official of the community where he currently resides **and** by a member of good standing of the Triskelion Grand Fraternity or Sorority who is not related to the applicant by virtue of marriage or consanguinity.
2. Scholarship winners will be selected and awards made on the basis of scholastic achievements, community involvement, financial need and completion of an essay which shows full understanding of the Triskelion

Grand Fraternity Tenets and Codes of Conduct. In reviewing the scholarship application, consideration may be given to geographic distribution of the scholarships.

3. The NTI Scholarship Application Form must be postmarked or received by fax or email no later than April 15, 2010.
4. Scholarship winners will receive annual payments of P20,000.00–P50,000.00 for each year they are enrolled in an accredited college, university or technical/vocational school as a non-probationary student for up to four years;
5. Payment is dependent on written evidence of graduation from high school (HS Diploma) and report card showing the recipient belongs to the top 30% of the graduating class and enrollment in an accredited institution of higher learning or a technical/vocational school, if a high school graduate or Transcript of Record showing the GPA, if a college undergraduate;
6. Payment of subsequent stipends is dependent on the recipient's continued eligibility as outlined in the Scholarship Acceptance Agreement.

Process for Applying

1. Read the Instructions page thoroughly.
2. You and your parent (for students under the age of 18) must sign and date the application before submitting it to your school officials. Your signatures will authorize your school to release information about you as well as verify that the information you provided is true.
3. Print legibly all answers in the application form using blue ink. Application forms that are illegible will be disqualified.
4. Send all required documents.

- Completed application form
 - Transcript of Records (if a college undergraduate)
 - High School diploma or HS report card (if a High School graduate)
 - Letters of Recommendation
 - Copies of your most recent Individual Income Tax return and your spouse's Income Tax return (if married) or your parents' income tax return (if applicable).
 - Proof of enrollment
5. Letter of Recommendation must contain the author's dated signature, complete name, office or department, position or designation and must be typewritten on official stationery.
 6. Do not send any material other than requested.

- The Scholarship Committee will have the full discretion to make the final decisions concerning the number of scholarships awarded each year, the amounts awarded and the winners of each of the scholarships. The Scholarship Committee shall also have full discretion in deciding whether a scholarship is to be continued or deferred for any period of time. All decisions of the Scholarship Committee shall be accorded the maximum deference allowed under the law.
- Scholarship winners will be notified via mail and email by May 15, 2010 and their names will be posted on the NTI website, www.northeasttriskelion.org.
- Any applicant may ask NTI by email to scholarship@northeasttriskelion.org to review a denied application within 30 days from the date the applicant has been notified. Any request for review will be granted immediately.
